LCCC Urges NO on Recall of Governor Newsom

California – During their monthly board meeting on Thursday, August 5, the Latino Caucus of California Counties (LCCC) voted unanimously to take a stand in opposition of the recall and in support of Governor Gavin Newsom.

“The State of California, under Governor Newsom’s leadership, has made many advancements in protecting immigrants, expanding healthcare, making progress on housing and homelessness, advancing a more inclusive curriculum in our schools, extending more resources to local governments, and doing everything to overcome the COVID-19 pandemic,” said **LCCC President V. Manuel Perez (Riverside County – 4th District)**. “Supporting the recall would likely reverse these and other advancements that we have made collectively as a state. For these reasons, it is important that Latinos and all Californians come out and vote in support of Governor Newsom and vote “No” on the recall, on Tuesday, September 14th.”
