LCCC Urges NO on Recall of Governor Newsom

California – During their monthly board meeting on Thursday, August 5, the Latino Caucus of California Counties (LCCC) voted unanimously to take a stand in opposition of the recall and in support of Governor Gavin Newsom.

"The State of California, under Governor Newsom's leadership, has made many advancements in protecting immigrants, expanding healthcare, making progress on housing and homelessness, advancing a more inclusive curriculum in our schools, extending more resources to local governments, and doing everything to overcome the COVID-19 pandemic," said **LCCC President V.
